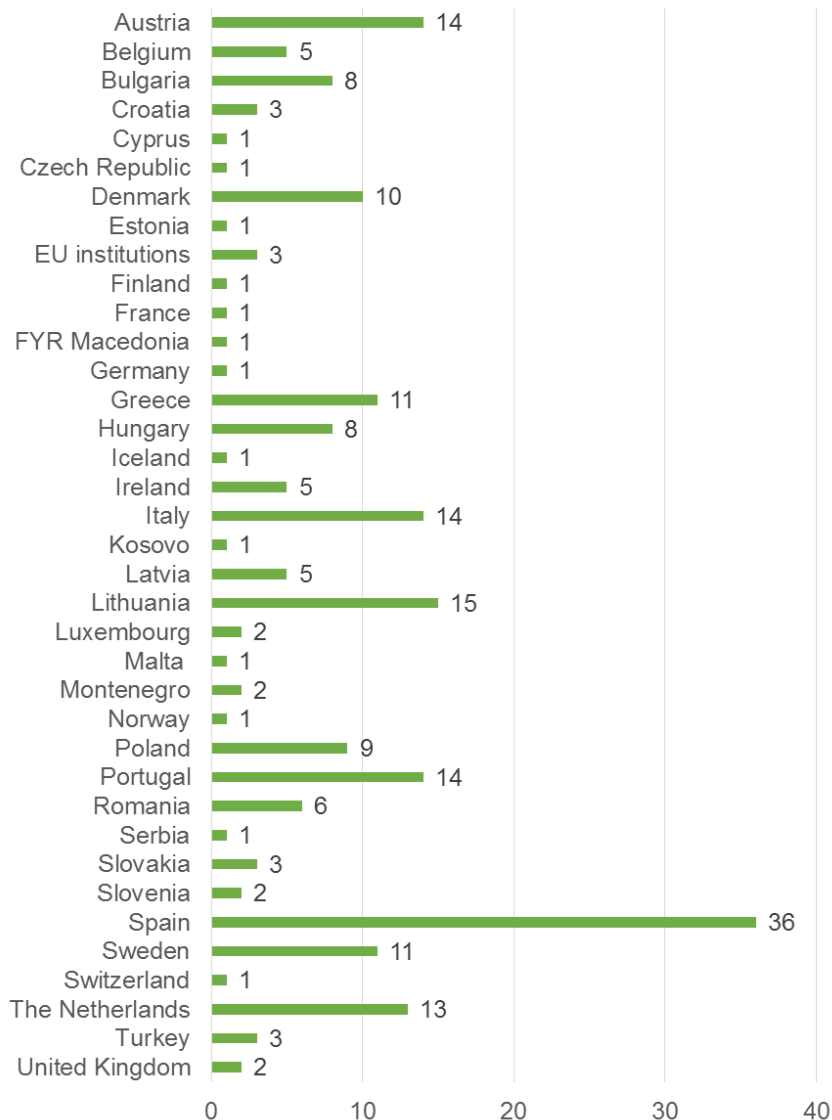

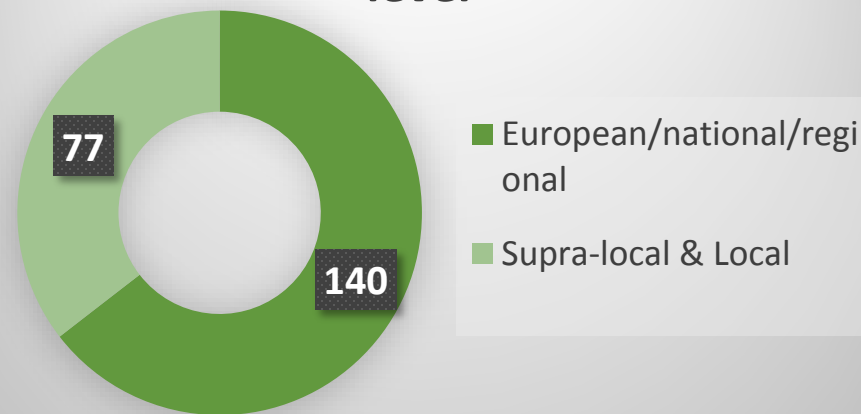

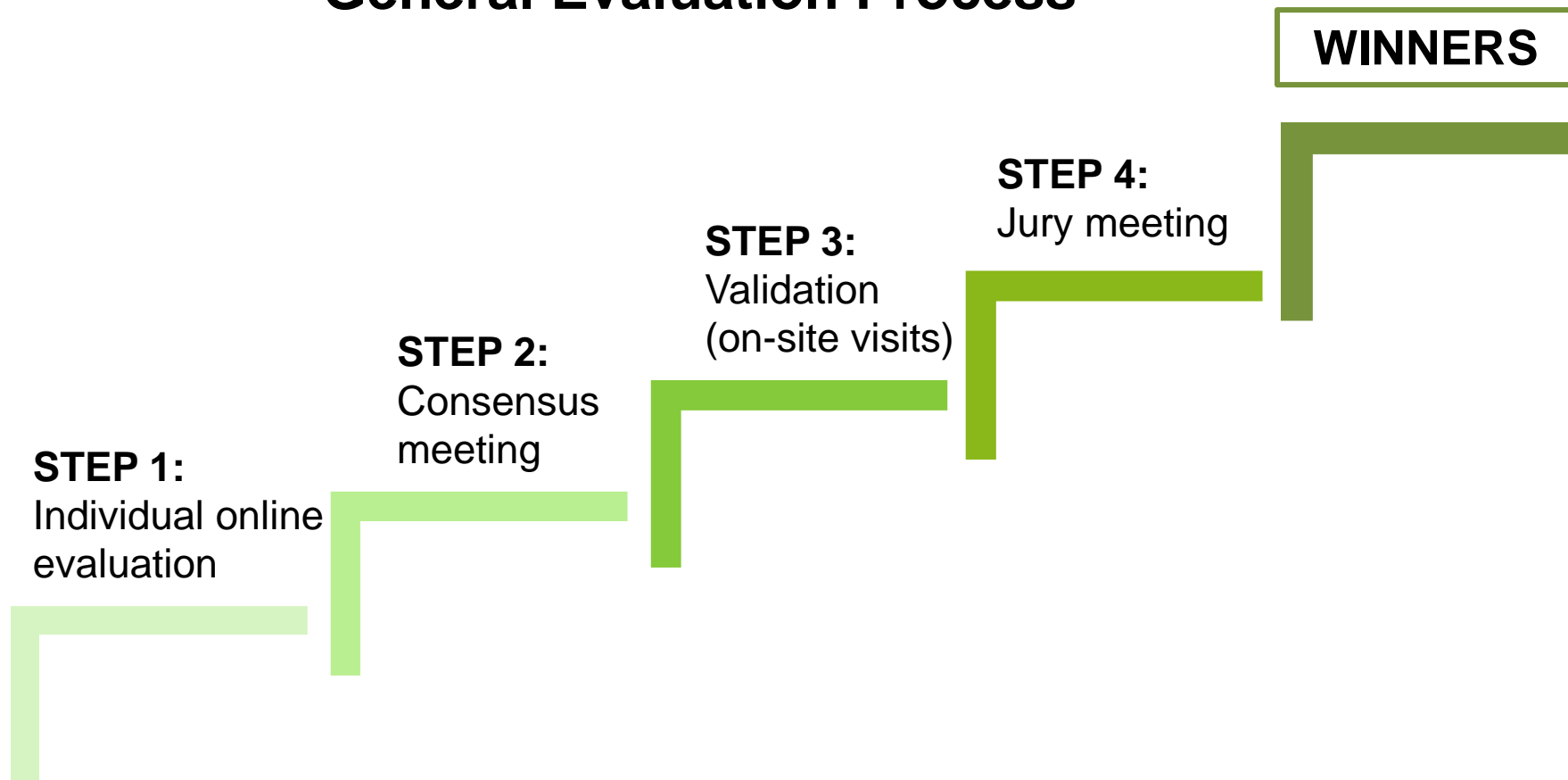
Applications by administrative level

Innovation

- Building knowledge, developing of products, promoting of research, providing evidence and encouraging improvement **on the health perspective in the design of cities**, all together this is truly novel and innovative.

Effective engagement by government with stakeholders

- The project creates clear synergies between different areas of political action and across **13 administrative departments (involving 49 professionals from 15 different disciplines)** to promote healthy urban environments (horizontal and vertical administrative cooperation).
- It demonstrates active communication between departments and government layers **beyond legislative obligations**. Health is integrated into others policies not only by regulation, but mainly by **“leading by example”**.



Sustainability

- The provincial government acts as “**consultant**”! In financial terms, it seems that it has caused only minimal out of pocket expenditures.

Transferability and Learning Capacity

- There is a very high level of transferability. Administrations all over Europe will find **inspiration and many lessons learnt** in this project.
